The Minister for Education, Prof. Jane Naana Opoku Agyemang, has commissioned an ultra modern school facility called Galaxy International School in Accra. The school is the first of its kind in Ghana with the sole aim of preparing their students to favourably

compete in the rapidly changing global environment, Whiles creating a serene atmosphere that stimulate academic discourse. The new school Building has encompasses about 12 000 m2 closed area by a play ground having long tennis, football,volleyball and basketball fields.Commissioning ceremony started with the opening prayers of chairman of the National Peace Council Most. Rev. Emmanuel Asante and the spokesperson for National Chief Imam, Sheikh Armyawo. The Minister announced that the Ministry of Education through Ghana Education Service has collaborated effectively with the private sector in the delivery of quality education in Ghana and that, this partnership is greatly acknowledged and appreciatedby government. She further stated that history has shown that private schools always have been a feature in Ghana's education landscape and their importance has been growing at every stage of education. She however cautioned that the responsibility of government to monitor private schools to ensure that they provide educational services that meet the prescribed standard and the needs of the local community and the country as a whole. She said that Galaxy international school is a good example of the important role of the private sector in education. She continued by stating that she is informed that students of Galaxy Int School have represented Ghana in international Olympiads and have brought home 45 medals and a lot accomplishments. Many of its graduates are currently studying in 31 different universities across the globe serving as good ambassadors of Ghana as well as their own nations She concluded by congratulating galaxy international school for these great successes and achievements over the years. Managing Director of the School, Mr. Yusuf Temizkan during his welcome address indicated that education is the most effective vehicle for change to a better world because the solution of every problem in human life depends on the initiatives and capacities of human beings themselves. Inspired by this, Galaxy International School has since 2001 served all people regardless of race, colour or faith, and this is the core pillar upon which the School will continue in its service to humanity. Mr. Yusuf further indicated that at Galaxy International School, students of all cultures are taught universal values and ethics along with modern sciences. He added that teachers at galaxy focus on individual differences because each individual is a differentworld. He informed the gathering that the school has served as a bridge between Ghana, Turkey and the rest of the world and that it has been very instrumental in making Ghana known in Turkey and vice versa through intercultural festivals and language Olympiads. As part of the school's corporate social responsibility to the country it offers scholarships to Ghanaian students.Mr.Yusuf thanked the government of Ghana, the Ghana Education Service, officials, parents, staff, students, and all well wishers for their immense contribution towards the success of the school and completion of the new secondary school building. The chairman for the occasion Prof. Kofi Anyidoho in his speech said after the tour of the classrooms, computer, science laboratories and other school facilities he could tell that this is how a learning environment is supposed to be; an ideal place that challenges students to give out their best. Amazed by the nature of the facilities of the school, he described the school as a 'galaxy ideal' that other African schools must emulate. The event was graced with the presence of many dignitaries from both home and far. The Hon.Minister of State Rashid Pelpuo represented, along side the chairman of the National Peace Council Most.
